Summary of Position:

This position as an essential contributor to the LTS will oversee and manage all logistics activities and related systems information. Areas of responsibility include but are not limited to logistics, distribution, warehousing, receiving, receiving inspection, inventory control, material handling, import-export of products, shipment of products from place of origin to point of delivery, third-party warehousing, will work closely with the import-export-trade compliance team and corporate transportation team. Develops and implements global logistics plans, budgets, and procedures to maximize compliance with customer needs within budget constraints. Provides financial reporting and reconciliation of inventories. Exhibits thorough understanding of Quality systems/ISO 13485. Interacts with vendors and peers in Purchasing, Planning, Manufacturing, Sales, Finance, and Product Development personnel to optimize systems and procedures. Selects, mentors, develops, and evaluates personnel to ensure the efficient operation of the Logistics function.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Interpret data on logistics elements, such as availability, reliability, supply chain management, strategic sourcing or distribution and supplier management.
- Assess and recommend optimal shipping methods, carriers, routing, equipment, or frequency to meet required transportation parameters, delivery specifications and costs . Recommend carrier base and negotiates rates for CDD Niche's international logistics needs.
- Monitor import or export processes to ensure legal and regulatory compliance.
- Collaborate with other departments to integrate logistics with business systems or processes, such as customer sales, order management, accounting, or planning.
- Direct WW distribution center operations to ensure achievement of cost, productivity, accuracy, and OTD (On time delivery).
- Conduct or review audits for logistics activities, such as storage, distribution, or transportation.
- Develop and implement methods to maintain accurate inventory levels at the facility. Manage cycle counts effectively for timely and accurate completion.
- Perform total landed cost analysis and provides routine updates to internal and/or external stakeholders
- Develop and maintain international transportation SOPs with freight forwarders and other logistics service providers
- Develop or maintain modles for logistics uses, such as cost estimating or demand forecasting.
